



California State Water Board Workshop Report

On January 18th there was a State Water Board Workshop from 1 to 5pm in San Bernardino regarding suction dredging and its impact on the mercury content of California's waterways. The issues presented by Board personnel included: 1. Should dredge permits be issued? 2. What types of equipment should be permitted? 3. What kind of protective practices should be required? 4. Should monitoring be required? And 5. What prohibitions should apply? The California Legislature has actually moved to create a path for existing statutory prohibition against dredging to move forward. This is so based on the recently enacted SB 637 (effective Jan. 1, 2016) which sets up a two step process – 1. The Water Board 1st must issue a permit or a waiver to dredge and then 2. The Dept. of Fish & Wildlife issues a permit. The bad news is that it will take until 2018 before the Water Board develops regulations to structure the 1st step of the permit process.
