## Miner's Cookbook Corner: By Judy Carpenter

#### **Cheesy Broccoli Rice Casserole**

**INGREDIENTS:** 

10 ounces frozen chopped broccoli, thawed 2 cups cooked rice

2 ½ cups sharp cheddar cheese, shredded

2 – 10 ½ ounce cans of cream of chicken or mushroom soup

1-5 ounces can Evaporated milk (I like Carnations)

1 small white onion, diced ½ cup celery, diced

1 cup of cooked white chicken, cubed ½ teaspoon salt & pepper 2 tablespoons butter

#### **DIRECTIONS**

Sauté onions and celery in the butter until soft, Add chicken, salt And pepper

In a large bowl, combine the soup, milk, cooked rice, broccoli, onions and chicken.

Fold in about 2 cups of the shredded cheese.

After mixing together pour into a greased 2-quart casserole dish.

Use the remaining cheese to top the casserole dish.

Bake at 350 for 25-30 minutes to melt the cheese and heat thoroughly.
